Biography

Ron Mazur obtained his Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering in 1971, and his Masters of Science in Electrical Engineering in 1989, both from the University of Manitoba. He has been a registered engineer with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Manitoba since 1974. Presently, Ron is the Manager of the System Planning Department, Transmission Planning & Design, Transmission & Distribution Business Unit.

After graduation Ron worked for Atomic Energy of Canada Limited for 4 years. Ron joined Manitoba Hydro in 1974. He worked in the station design area and then in system operations before he moved to the System Planning Department in 1986.

Ron has extensive experience in system planning and operating at Manitoba Hydro, and has served on numerous MAPP subcommittees and working groups. Ron was the chair of the MAPP Transmission Planning Subcommittee from 1997 to 2003, and led the subcommittee development of the MAPP regional planning process and MAPP Ten-Year Plan development.
